

TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIPS IN ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

The Environmental Studies Program invites applicants for 2008-09 Teaching Assistantships. Assistantships will be awarded for the two course Environmental Studies Core sequence (ENST 212 and 213) and up to two additional upper division courses in Environmental Studies. Advanced graduate students who specialize in Environmental topics, regardless of academic discipline, are encouraged to apply.

Teaching Assistants complete all reading assignments, attend class lectures, lead discussion, hold office hours for students, meet regularly with faculty to discuss course material and teaching strategies, and design and grade class assignments and exams.

Teaching Assistants receive a salary of \$1,500 per course.

To apply, you should submit a C.V., cover letter discussing your interest in and qualifications for the position, and a letter of recommendation from a faculty member familiar with your work to Dean Clason, Pick 118 by Friday, May 16, 2008.
